Peru Ranked 8th Best Place to Retire in Illinois

Peru, Illinois – The city of Peru has been ranked as the 8th best place to retire in Illinois. <u>The study</u> — now in its second year — was conducted by <u>SmartAsset</u>, a New York financial technology company. Peru rose 9 places, up from number 17 in last year's study.

SmartAsset rated 4,700 U.S. cities based on "factors that affect quality of life for retirees," including tax friendliness, healthcare accessibility, and availability of recreational and social opportunities for seniors. All factors were weighted equally and indexed.

Peru scores better than the national average on tax rates, healthcare accessibility, and the availability of retirement centers, and scores the same as the national average when it comes to the availability of recreation centers in the community.
